Meeting #12 Feb 18th — Page 67 - 73 — English/German Tales Study The Law of Falling

Attendees: Robin, Paula, Vanya, Ekant, Bobbie, Sandra

Sandy: Stunned to find out that bernstein means 'amber'. Such a common name ..!

3rd para on p71.

Fallgesetz – means 'law of gravity'?

Ekant: We would never use it in German and it is translated as law of gravity or law of falling bodies – used in physics.

Sandy: Not used in physics – only in Gurdjieff Work?

RB: A term they wouldn't understand at all

Perhaps one of the most important parts of the book – there is a force that operates in the spheres of influence of planets and suns to initiate a falling, a movement towards and that situation changes as soon as atmosphere is encountered. A lower 'do' of an octave at the center of planets and suns – corresponding to the 'do' of the Absolute. The negative of God himself that sits at the center of planets and suns.

Bobbie: Impressed that the law of falling could be how I use attention and that came from the reading the other night from Ferapontoff in his 'principles'. Then I watch in some waiting rooms and if there is a TV their attention goes to that and then if someone comes in the door, it moves – or on their iPhones.

PS: If to do with our attention, what is the difference between system of Hariton and Venoma?

Bobbie: I think about aging

RB: Law of falling – about self-remembering ... nature of negativity. It is true that people will 'fall to the bottom' – if there is a room with a TV ..

Vanya: Trying to work out the system of ships ... today I lost my stability or center in a conversation. Then when we talked, I first had the idea I was falling – lost my attention. Then came aspect of negativity – as if when I come to an atmosphere where I cant manoeuvre, I am lost and go that that planet ... can't keep my attention and go where I want to go. Goes to something – to this gravity. Don't have something in me which can keep it. The cylinder.

Helpful that I read it yesterday because I was able to observe it.

Bobbie: Cylinder – take a breath

PS: I was also getting an image of breath when listening to this ... fills then empties and then has to fill ...

Bobbie: Works on negative pressure value.

Vanya: p67 – difference in German and English.

German translates to from which forces flow and are ... concentrated – no 'tend'. Passive act and not active.

Ekant doesn't think it is so different. The word for 'tend' is not so common.

Ekant: The use of the law of falling in a good sense could mean to 'go with what is'

Bobbie: Like when they faced the Zilnotrago and decided to wait.

Ekant: I just orient myself towards a thing and let myself be drawn and not be distracted too easily. Has to do with attention.

Sandra: ... word for purgatory Fegefeuer

Ekant: that is really all that word is used to mean

Ekant: 185?

RB: 38 years different from 223

Ekant: and 23 years to next generation of ships. 3 looniases

RB: months

Sandra: Calculations are interesting. Idea of captain's age ... 200 ... interesting as to who the captain is and when he is meeting him.

Ekant: p70 para 1. very much care and considerable knowledge – in German translates to care and attention.

Vanya: Only needed when there is a sun or planet – otherwise it works when no distraction. And you have to reduce your speed to pass.

Ekant: And again the comets. Especially distracting.

PS: Easy to maintain attention on my own in quiet. If in a room full of people ... if sexual overtones, more distracting.

Bobbie: Soort - Latin fate, destiny - or wanting to sort or categorise things ...

Sandra: Have to ask what we know about Saint Venoma – did we meet him before?

Bobbie: In last line of previous chapter – about ships.

Ekant: Had been taken from the planet and in German is occupation or hobby, not favourite work.

Bobbie: Who is Saint Venoma to the Captain – intellectual center?

Ekant: Almost like 'phenomena'. When we compare the two ships – had ships that had to carry material and throw it out to move forward.

Maybe first is mechanical doing, second is attracted attention and third is directed attention. A starting point to think of these principles.

Bobbie: Falling is our first fear before we have words – baby ...

Sandra: and mention of an infant in the English – German?

Vanya: a recently-originated being

PS: Would say 'new born'

RB: System of Saint Venoma is describing impartiality. Isn't any problem with anything entering into that space but is necessary to have the energy for it.

Could say great accumulator feeding you H12 to be able to resist anything you encounter ... In situations when you encounter other people it is difficult to be impartial.

Vanya: And the system of Hariton would be what – if Venoma is impartial?

RB: The energy required in the system of Saint Venoma – that is true. Thinking it is the second conscious shock – doesn't depend on the outside at all and hasn't got any connection to the outside. Doesn't deal with incoming impressions at all.

Vanya: He says that the cosmic materials come in on p71.

Ekant: Orgone – Reich accumulator – made from a chamber with walls that are made from organic and non-organic materials alternatively. Should attract the cosmic substance called orgone. Had a therapist who had one in his garden and he said it works – gives strong energy.

RB: Easy to make an Orgone accumulator – only need tin foil ... America wanted to destroy Wilhelm Reich. May be there was money to be made in it not being available or that it was dangerous. Difficult to find anyone working with it.

With Tesla they gathered all his stuff and made sure that no-one could get at it. A lot of situations where an individual is destroyed ... don't understand.

PS: Pecked to death.

Ekant: A system for accumulating these materials ...

PS: Or maybe just through breathing.

Sandra: Not really like spaceships

Ekant: In E Germany when I was younger there was a lot of science fiction that wasn't really fiction.

PS: We have Star Trek!

Ekant: Can't only be the lungs ...

PS: Not just lungs – breathing

Bobbie: Glottis and epiglottis. Work to exchange a position so that we can breathe and eat food. It is amazing.

RB: Almost like there was a design error and someone said we should put this mechanism it and now it is OK.

Sandra: rays ... besides etherokrilno there is Elekilpomagtistzen ...

Bobbie: Basque for school with the first part. -nian – a state.

Adossia – seed. Hariton – prayer by a shaman.

Vanya: Archangels – only Michael in the bible. Brings the message from God and the Angels more for the individual. Doesn't make sense here. Also can move from angel to archangel.

Bobbie: Was promoted.

RB: Organs of the body and equivalent to planets – correspondence between cosmoses. There were 7 archangels for each day of the week. Probably Jewish.

Sandra: In some religions are thousands and they are ranked – cherubim, archangels, principals, thrones ...

Ekant: What is the hierarchy of the organs in that case?

RB: Will probably become clearer ... referring to organs of the body.

Bobbie: Could be systems of the body ...

RB: He doesn't do it that way. There is a relationship ... Important that Venoma is a Saint and not an angel. Presiding over a mechanism. Venoma is an odd name – has venom in it.

Bobbie: Saint has lived and died – angel not.

Ekant: There are organs that create poison

Bobbie: Bile

RB: That is the duct by which the liver excretes poisons – only other means is through the skin – sweat.

Bobbie: Maybe female version of venom.

Vanya: In the German is a 'he'

Sandra: Also in the English - called 'he'

RB: G couldn't pronounce the letter 'h' – so could be khariton.

Sandra: p69 Etzikolnionachmschen'-Strahlen

Ekant: There is a spelling error – I will correct.

RB: Archangels: Michael | Gabriel Raphael Uriel Azrael Selaphiel Jeremiel.

Surt means "sour" or "grumpy." in Swedish and Norwegian

RB: He refers to ether and etherokrilno – might be that he is distinguishing – not clear. He spells with 'e' and not 'ae' – not clear.

RB:

'The centers of all the suns and of all the planets of our Universe

are just such points of "stability." They are the lowest points

of those regions of space upon which forces from all directions of

the given part of the Universe definitely tend and where they are

concentrated. In these points there is also concentrated the equilibrium

which enables suns and planets to maintain their position.'

Science doesn't know how suns and planes maintain their position – pretends that it is somehow due to gravity, but if you formulate a mathematical problem with a large mass in the center, you don't get the distribution that there is. Very unusual for orbits to cross and there is a formula to work out where planets will be in relation to the Sun – nothing to do with gravity. (Bode's Law) There is a necessary stability ... he talks about harmony – planetary harmony matters. He makes that comment everywhere – about yourself, your harmony matters. The organs of your body are planets and if their harmony is disturbed, you tend to die. Any disharmony in the body normally leads to severe illness and death. You never ask yourself – in most cases your body looks after itself for decades in a way that you have no idea about. You don't know how to breathe at the right volume and speed. The beating of your heart ... The way your nervous system works is miraculous ... you have no way of unlearning. You walk in a way that you learned.

Bobbie: If you break a leg or both – you have to re-learn how to walk. The intellect has to work it out. Thankful for the shock and how to recover.

So many things we do automatically.

RB: Do you remember learning to read? I do. I remember a teacher testing me ... I saw the word 'gnome' and I spelled it correctly when she asked me. I remember my finger moving along sentences. You can't learn how to not read. If you see any words you automatically read them – impossible not to. If you go and live in a place where you can't read the words it is really interesting.

Bobbie: How quickly we are attracted when we see something we recognise - law of falling maybe?

RB: The addict – they fall into it. People who fall into a poisonous relationship and don't know

how to escape. I think the law of falling refers to that. Important to understand – the Earth is in layers and the layers go solid, water, then air – but a lot of mixed layers – can count 9 layers of atmosphere. If you are a substance, have to get to the right layer to be able to interact with something. This law of falling relates to the law of three. Tenikdoa – law of gravity – describes how things rise up to the stratosphere.

Ekant: Points of stability have something to do with Moon in oneself

RB: Lower than the moon – have to look at the step diagram to get a sense of that – point where substances condense and can no longer rise. In center of Earth, not sure it is in the center of moons. When does a moon acquire stability? One of the moons of Mars is only about 35Km across – not a growing thing. He says 'center of suns and planets' – not moons. Later in The Tales he describes the creation (in Holy Planet Purgatory) of planets, but not moons. Proper position of the moon – is actually an embryo. Not a fetus until it can spin. Will come across that later.

RB: The reason I thought the system of Hariton is transformation – the denser material creates more energy. Like absolute hatred, more energy than boredom.

Worth repeating – 2 types of space travel: between planets and between systems. Planets corresponds with going between states in yourself and system is going between states in the outer world.

Bobbie: a sphere without atmosphere, that

is, a space containing only World Etherokrilno, is for contemporary

ships also the best, because in such a sphere there is no resistance

at all, and the 'Law of Falling' can therefore be fully employed

in it without any assistance from the work of the cylinder.

RB: Hari is Sanskrit and used to refer to Visnu – removes sins, darkness, illusion. Thin, but an association that might work.

"Hari" is a Sanskrit word Vishnu.

It can mean "the one who takes away" (sins) or "the one who removes darkness and illusion."

In the tone of Vishnu.

Ekant: System of Hariton is everywhere at the present day – not right unfortunately.

RB: When he says it is now used everywhere referring to the body of knowledge he has introduced.

PS: Maybe at a point of development or maturity.

RB: Always making outrageous claims.
